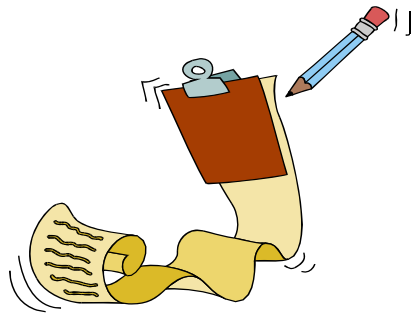
Please come...we need your ideas!! If you cannot attend make sure to contact the Hockey Mom President or someone you know that has attended the meeting so you don't miss any important information.
